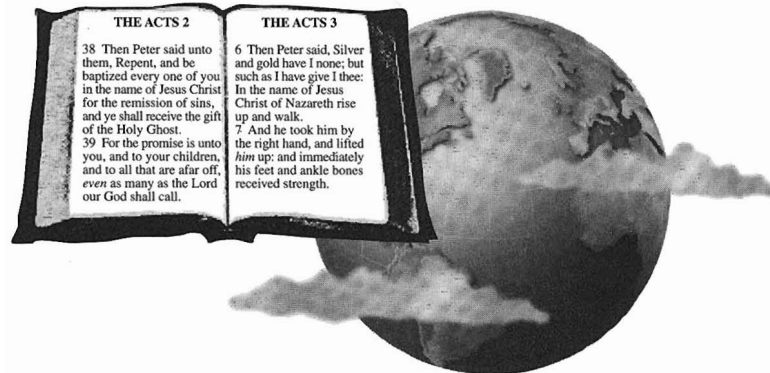

Dear Mr. Quander:

Thank you for your letter of July 20, 2007 responding to our questions and concerns regarding Fugitive Safe Surrender ("FSS"). Thank you also for meeting with us on July 25, 2007 to further outline the program. In response to your request, Bible Way Church would be honored to partner with the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency for the District of Columbia ("CSOSA") and the District of Columbia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council ("CJCC") to provide non-violent fugitive offenders the opportunity to surrender in a non-threatening environment—our church, to face their charges, have their cases heard, and make a fresh start.

It is our hope that, through our joint effort, thousands of men and women will be encouraged to take advantage of FSS, not only in Washington, DC, but nationwide. We believe in the goals and mission of FSS as they closely align with the mission of our church, namely, the redemption and salvation of men, women, families, the neighborhood, the community, the city, and the nation.


